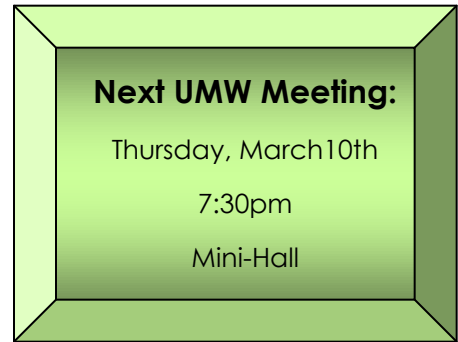





Kevin Marchese Memorial Fund

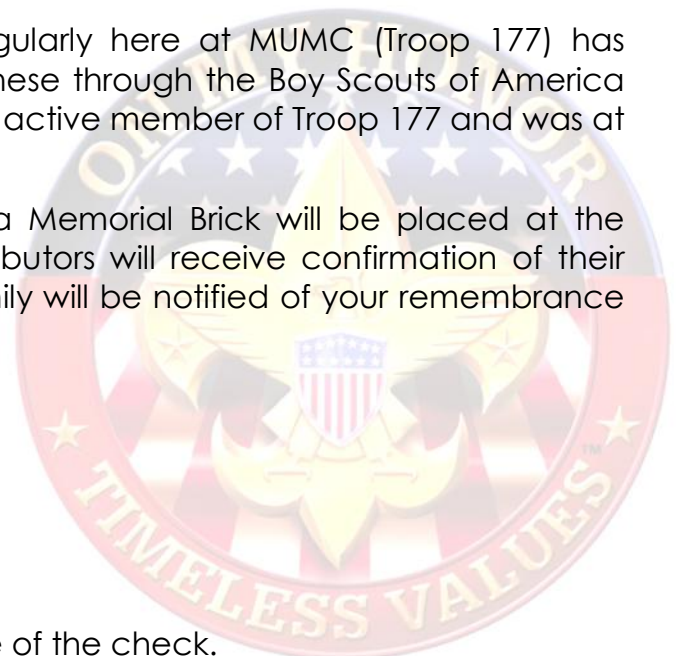

Barb's Seamless Crocheted Baby Hat



Hat Size Guidelines

Size: full term newborn (13" circumference)

Materials: size F hook, 1.5 oz. baby yarn

Gauge: 9 sc = 2 inches

(sc=single crochet; slst=slip stitch; rnd=round *may also be done in half double crochet)

Pattern

1. ch 4, join w sl st to form ring
2. ch 1, work 10 sc in ring, do not join w sl st, keep working in rounds
3. 2 sc in ea sc around (20 sc)
4. work 1 rnd even (20 sc)
5. 2 sc in ea sc around (40 sc)
6. work 1 rnd even (40 sc)
7. *1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc*, rep from * to * around (60 sc)
8. continue working sc in rounds until cap measures 8" from top to bottom
9. end off, weave end into outside edge
10. turn up 2" cuff

Preemie size F Hook

Newborn size G Hook

1/2 oz of Caron Simply Soft Yarn

Top of hat

Ch 2

Rnd 1: Make 15 dc into the 2nd ch from the hook, join with sl st into top of first dc.

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (counts as a dc), dc into same st, *dc, 2 dc in next st. Repeat from * around and join with sl st. (23 sts)

Rnd 3: Ch 2, dc into next st, *2 dc in next st, dc in next 2 sts. Repeat from * around and join with sl st. (30 sts)

Rnd 4: (Preemie size) dc in each st and join with sl st. **Rnd 5-8** Repeat rnd 4.

For Newborn size:

Rnd 4: Ch 2, dc into next st, *2 dc in next st, 1 dc in each of the next 3 sts. Repeat from * around and join with sl st.

Rnd 5: Dc in each st and join with sl st. **Rnd 6-9:** Repeat rnd 5.

Final Round for Brim

Ch 2, dc into front post of the dc below, then dc into back post of the next dc below. Keep alternation fp and bp around. Join.

You can add a pom-pom and a ribbon woven through the brim row, or leave the hat bare. Both look cute!

You can also vary the size of preemie hat just by using the f hook with the newborn instructions, or doing fewer sts at the top, adding more sts to make it larger. Play around with this and have fun.
