Hello beloved, I greet you in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. As we enter December, we are reminded by the world that we are entering the Christmas season. However, that season doesn't really begin until Christmas Day. Right now, we are in the season of Advent.

Advent is a time of the church year when we prepare for the coming of our Messiah. We remember that the world was in darkness, and Jesus came to bring the light of God into this world. We also remember the promise that our Lord has given us through the prophet Isaiah. In Isaiah 7:14, we see that God has promised us a Messiah, born from a virgin, and called Immanuel. In Isaiah 9:2, the author continues, "The people walking in darkness have seen a great light; on those living in the land of deep darkness a light has dawned."

During this precious season of Advent, we are still living in the dark until Christ comes back into our world with hope and eternal life. Our lives will be a time of hope-filled struggle. However beloved, I want you to remember that Jesus delivered us from the slavery of sin and death, which started with Mary giving birth to our Messiah.
